

Knight's Glamping

Families and couples can now escape to the countryside for a glamorous camping holiday with a difference.

Bookable from April to September, guests will stay in a traditionally coloured striped pavilion, based on a Medieval design, within the one-acre Castle vineyard.

By day, explore the magnificent Castle and beautiful 500 acres of grounds, then at night, sleep under canvas, as Henry VIII's entourage would have done in 1520 when they stayed at Leeds Castle.

Enjoy the luxury of a four poster bed, warming log burning stove, crisp cotton bedding and snug rugs during your stay.

Breakfast hampers can be delivered to your tent or a full English cooked breakfast is available from the Fairfax Restaurant.

A short stroll from the campsite, the nearby Knight's Cottage provides guests with shower facilities and a spacious sitting room.

Each pavilion accommodates two adults in a four poster bed. Up to two additional children can stay for a supplementary charge.

Holiday Cottages

Each of Leeds Castle's five charming self-catering holiday cottages has its own style and historic setting just a stone's throw from the magnificent 900 year old Castle. Whilst retaining their historic charm, the cottages provide thoroughly modern facilities and all have received self-catering awards from Visit England. Guests also receive free entry to Leeds Castle and use of a local hotel's leisure facilities.

For a romantic break in the Kent countryside, **Weir Cottage** is a cosy, dog friendly property for two people.

Keeper's House is the largest of our holiday cottages, overlooking the River Len. The three bathrooms and five bedrooms which sleep ten people, make it ideal for larger parties.

A short walk from the Castle's maze and sleeping six people each, **Knight's Cottage** and the newly refurbished **Earl's Cottage** offer two families the chance to stay in adjoining cottages overlooking the vineyard. Knight's Cottage is available from October to March.

The Guard's House is a beautiful Grade II listed traditional Kentish ragstone cottage. Sleeping six, this dog-friendly property offers the ideal getaway for those who love the outdoor life.
