

LEEDS CASTLE

SCAFFOLDING TOURS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All attendees must hold a valid Leeds Castle admission ticket for the date of their visit.
- This tour is not suitable for anyone under the age of 16, anyone with a fear of heights or with poor balance or vertigo.
- Attendees need to be physically fit enough to climb up ladders and through access hatches to reach each level of scaffold. The scaffold will take you all the way up to the roof, and involve navigating 5 ladders up.
- The tour is held outdoors and will take place even during rain, however, it will not be possible to hold the tour in high winds.
- If the Met Office issue high wind warning in advance, Leeds Castle will contact attendees, however, it may be necessary to cancel at short notice on the day.
- Attendees will need to wear warm clothing and coats, that will allow for climbing up ladders and being outdoors at height. Footwear needs to be robust, walking shoes or boots with good grip and sturdy thick soles are recommended.
- PAYE Stone Masons will provide a site safety induction for walking on the scaffold and issue full PPE before the tour commences.
- You will be issued with and required to wear: gloves, safety glasses, hard hat & hi vis vest.
- Attendees are required to arrive at the Castle Main Entrance by 10.15 or 13.15 for the tour where staff will greet and direct to the collection point for the tour.
- The Castle is approx. 10-15 minutes' walk from the Visitor Centre entrance and the car park, so please arrive at the Visitor Centre at least 30 minutes before the time stated on your booking.
